Rules, Regulations and Entry Form for the Pullet Project Hernando County Fair Youth Livestock Show & Sale

Sponsored By: Hernando County Fair Association

Entry Deadline: Monday, October 21st, 2019. Sign-in 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
(Limited to 15 lottery entries)

Mandatory Meeting/Pick-up: Monday, October 21st, 2019 meeting starting at 6:00 p.m. in the auditorium at the Fairground. Pick up will be after the meeting.

- Information and your pullets will be issued this day

Fair Arrival: Thursday, April 2nd, 2020, 5:00 – 7:00 pm

Judging: Sunday, April 5th, 2020, Show 2:00 p.m. and Showmanship at 5:00 pm

Sale: Wednesday, April 8th, 2020, starting at 6:30 pm

Entry Fee: \$25 (includes 6 chicks only. You MUST have a brooder setup and ready to go before you receive the chicks.)

Removal: Wednesday, April 8th, 2020, after the sale. For more info, talk with Livestock Committee after Sale.

Pullet Project Information


The Hernando County Livestock Committee will provide participants with instruction and opportunities to learn to feed, water and care for chickens from the “day old hatching” stage to “ready-to-lay” pullets. This project will benefit young people by providing opportunities to develop self-responsibility, discipline, and persistence, and it will also provide a pathway into developing the character traits necessary to transition into larger animal projects.

To ensure uniformity (age, gender and breed) and to increase survivability, each participant will be given 6 chicks that have been purchased from the hatchery. Prior to receipt, all chicks will be vaccinated at the hatchery for Marek’s Disease and each participant will receive the health related information needed for the care of their new arrivals.

At the end of the project the participants will be encouraged to select their top 3 pullets to enter for judging at the Hernando County Fair. Each entry will be judged as a ready to lay set by an unbiased official and ribbons will be awarded. All age divisions are welcome to enroll. **It will be the responsibility of the exhibitors to identify and invite potential buyers and sales prices will not be guaranteed. All animals will be sold on April 19th, 2019.**

1. Pullets will be limited to the 15 lottery entries.
2. Exhibitors must select their top 3 pullets and bring them in ventilated container (no cardboard boxes) and may not be removed until inspection is complete, then may be placed directly into their cages. All storage containers must be removed from livestock barn during the fair. Exhibitors must make their own arrangements for delivery of the birds.
3. Once the birds have been received, exhibitors may not relocate their birds.
4. Exhibitors will be limited to showing FEMALE BIRDS ONLY around the age of 6 months.
5. ONLY PULLETS PROVIDED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION MAY BE SHOWN IN PULLET PROJECT.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Eligibility of Exhibitor: Qualified 4-H and FFA members must be enrolled and in good standing by **October 21st, 2019**
2. Eligibility of Animal: Exhibitors must have purchased their pullets from the Hernando County Fair Association by the entry deadline.
3.  Exhibitors to Hernando County from other counties must submit a letter (**two weeks prior to deadline**) to the HCFAYLC, expressing their reason for wanting to show in Hernando and not their County of residence. Approval may be allowed, after the HCFAYLC has contacted the County in which they reside, and verified the reasons to be true and justified.
 - Approval covers continuous showing years. If you have not shown within Hernando County in the previous year, you must submit another letter to be approved. Approved letters will last until after your final year providing you show continuously within Hernando County.
4. Exhibitors will be assigned stall/pen space by the HCFAYLC. Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their area clean and neat during the fair. The HCFAYLC will be using a Yellow and Red Tag Penalty System for making sure all animals are cared for and that the area in and around your stalls/pens are maintained. If a member of the HCFAYLC observes that your animal, or your stall/pen is being neglected you will receive a Yellow Tag (which is a warning), with the reason for it written on the tag. If the HCFAYLC notices your project/stall/pen is being neglected in any manner again, you will be given a Red Tag and fined \$50.00.
5. Due to limited space, it will be based off a lottery system.
6. NO ROOSTERS will be accepted as part of this project.
7. All eggs laid during the show become the property of the Livestock Committee.
8. Health requirements: Poultry will be tested by a livestock inspector on receiving day. State health and USDA requirements will supersede any other rules or health requirements.
9. Removal Date: All pullets must be removed from the barns after the sale. Talk with Livestock Committee after the sale. For more info contact Livestock Committee.
10. A chick pick-up meeting will be held on Monday, October 21st, 2019, at the Hernando County Fairgrounds. You will also be picking up your chicks at this time.
11. You will receive SIX chicks for your project. Only THREE may be entered in the fair at check-in.
12. The HCFAYLC would like to emphasize, general care, grooming, cleaning of stalls/pens, and feeding of animals. This will be the Responsibility of the Exhibitor, with assistance only from FFA Advisor, 4-H Leader, Livestock Committee, Parent/Guardian, or fellow exhibitor. Care and Feeding includes providing feed and water.
 - **All Rabbit and Poultry Exhibitors - Feeding of animals should be done at least once a day, and MUST be completed by 9:00 p.m. each day or one (1) hour after a show.**
 - **There will be no feeding, watering, or bathing of animals during any livestock show.**
 - **Additional care may be provided, at the discretion of the HCFAYLC.**
 - **Under the cages needs to be cleaned daily.**
13. SHOWMANSHIP: Poultry Showmanship will be held on April 5th, 2020, beginning at 5:00 p.m.
Showmanship is MANDATORY for all exhibitors except CLOVER BUDS (it is optional).
14. **BELT BUCKLE THANK YOU LETTERS APPLIES TO ALL LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS WINNING BELT BUCKLES.**

All Thank You letters for Belt Buckle Sponsors and Buyers are due Tuesday April 14th, 2020 between 4 p.m. to 8 p.m.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Letters **MUST** be handwritten in pen by the exhibitor.
 - Use a 5"x7" envelope for the pictures provided by the HCFAYLC.
 - Get your Buyer's and/or Belt Buckle Sponsor Addresses.
 - Address envelope provided by HCFAYLC, and place a stamp on it - **DO NOT SEAL ENVELOPE.**
 - Turn in your Thank You Letter/s. **BRING YOUR OWN STAMP - STAMPS ARE NOT PROVIDED**
15. Thank you Letters for Buyers and/or Belt Buckles are due on Tuesday, April 14th, 2020 between 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m... All Thank You Letters must be handwritten in pen by the exhibitor (Cloverbuds can write in pencil). Reminder: Exhibitors will be charged \$50.00 per buyer, add-on, and/or belt buckle for each appropriate thank you letter not received by the deadline. Youth are encouraged to turn letters in early so they can be reviewed and replaced if necessary.
16. Exhibitors agree and consent to the use of pictures, including but not limited to photographs and video, of you and/or your animal in any or all publications, TV, publicity brochure, internet site, or other publicity associated with the Hernando County Fair Youth Livestock Show & Sale. **Should you have a privacy issue, please let a Member of the HCFAYLC be aware of your situation, along with a letter to the office for documentation.**
17. Any questions or protest concerning compliance with the rules and regulations or the eligibility of an exhibitor or his/her animal must be submitted in writing to the Livestock Committee Chairman within 24 hours after the discovery of the infraction along with a fine of \$50. The HCFAYLC and/or Fair Board may investigate possible infractions of rules at any time. No protest will be accepted after and award is given.
18. Exhibitors Add-on list will be ready for pick-up Monday, May 4th, 2020 between 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. or Tuesday, May 5th, 2020 from 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Should the Fair Office receive any Add-on's for an exhibitor, after they have picked up their Add-on List, then the exhibitor will be contacted. Thank You letters for this add-on must be turned in before sales checks are received.
19. Appropriate and proper (**handwritten in pen by the exhibitor**) thank you letters for all add-ons must be turned in to the Fair Office either on May 11th, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. or the last day May 12th, 2020 from 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. All thank-you letters must be in an unsealed, stamped, and addressed envelope.

SALE OF PULLETS

1. Exhibitor may choose to auction off their project on Wednesday, April 8th, 2020, starting at 6:30 pm in the Livestock Barn. Awards at 6:00 pm.
2. Exhibitors should make arrangements with their respective buyer on issues concerning pick-up and delivery. The pullets need to be removed from the fairgrounds after the sale. Talk with Livestock Committee member for more information.
3. Buyers are encouraged to bring payment that night.
4. Checks from the sale will be picked up by the exhibitor when the checks are ready. You will be notified by your leader when the checks are ready for pick up.
